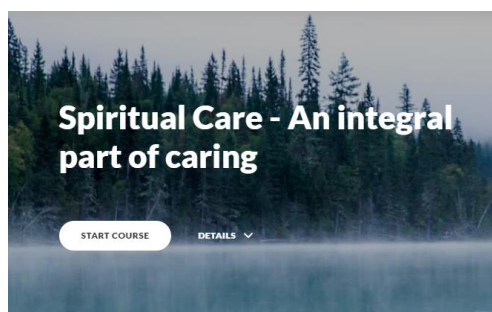
The e-module aligns with the new Single Aged Care Quality Standards and the National Guidelines for Spiritual Care in Aged Care.
